ADVOCACY UPDATES

WINDSOR HOTEL

There has been recent speculation about the future of the 107-year-old Windsor Hotel at 187 Garry. There is a



rumor that current owners want to sell the hotel so it can be demolished for surface parking. Though this is just a rumour, it is known that the current owners do want to sell the historic building. On Saturday, January 9, 2010, an outdoor rally was held for people who want to see the building saved. There is also an online petition at www.petitiononline.com/blu3/petition.html. The Windsor Hotel was built in 1903, as La Claire Hall boarding house in an area quickly developing into a modern residential neighbourhood. Over the years, the Windsor has survived through downtown Winnipeg's growth, and represents a style of architecture at the turn of the 20th century. The Windsor is best known as an excellent music venue for blues, and legendary actor Charlie Chaplin stayed there before he made it big in Hollywood.

Kelly House

Interior renovations to The Kelly House are now complete, and exterior renovations have started and will be completed in spring 2010. The current occupant, Cancer Care Manitoba, is almost finished moving in. Saving this house from the wrecking ball is a huge victory for the Exchange District. It is a remnant from an era when the Exchange District was a residential neighbourhood. Also, saving the Kelly House continues the trend of revitalization within the Exchange.





SPEAKUP WINNIPEG - HERITAGE OPEN HOUSE

On January 19, Speakup Winnipeg held a heritage open house at the Millennium Library in the Carol Shields Auditorium. Citizens were invited to join in the discussion on the significance of heritage preservation and its importance in Winnipeg.
