Executive Director Cindy Tugwell spoke in delegation at a Downtown Development, Heritage and Riverbank Management Committee meeting on Monday, May 27th. The committee voted unanimously to "support" the administration's recommendation to issue a Derelict Building Certificate for the property at 235 Notre Dame, as provided under subsection 5 of the Taking Title to Vacant & Derelic Buildings By-law 89/2010. Although it should be noted that through this process that the building owner, Ken Zaifman still has 120 days to put in a sprinker system to be inspected by the City of Winnipeg. We will have an update this summer on the final outcome.
