### Harbourmaster Building - 333 Waterfront Dr.

The former Harbourmaster building may soon be redeveloped into a restaurant and bar. The Sunstone Group intends to build a 67-room boutique hotel on a 71,000 square foot piece of land including the Alexander Docks and the former Harbourmaster building. The Province of Manitoba recommended that a Heritage Resources Impact Assessment be undertaken prior to construction because there may be archaeologically significant items on the site. The building has been vacant since Harbourmaster operations were moved to

Redboine Boating Club in 2005. The river trail through Stephen Juba Park will pass between the hotel and restaurant and be open to the public. We will continue to follow this project.
